REGULATIONS:

Only 1 entry form per exhibitor. Entry form must be accompanied by the entry fee or proof of payment. *Please print clearly* Each exhibit must be the work of the exhibitor and have been completed in the last 12 months. All exhibits will be displayed.

Exhibitors will be allowed a maximum of 2 exhibits per class.

Some classes have size limitations. Please check.

Please include a description of your item on the entry form

No late entries or refunds accepted.

The awarding of prizes is at the Judge's discretion. Places may not be awarded if it does not meet standard.

Exhibitor's names must not be visible prior to judging – an identifying name must be covered prior to being entered.
