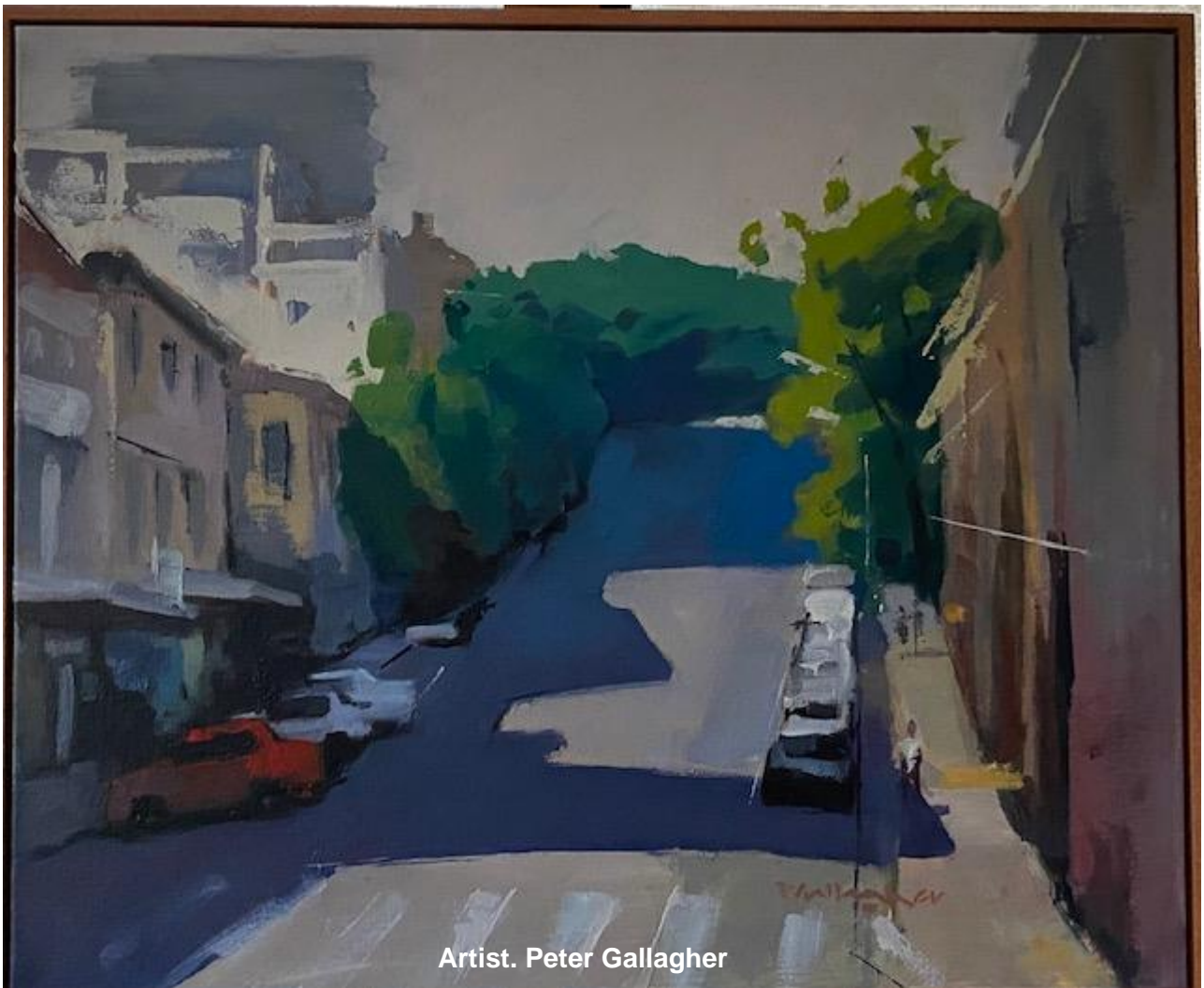

Artwork & Jewellery will be available for purchase at the Art Presentation Awards evening.

Please Note: Any Art and Jewellery purchases may be collected on completion of the three day show.

Artwork and Jewellery, will also be available for purchase during the Newcastle Show during the show period.

How to Purchase: A small deposit is normally required. We will attach a red dot on your selected artwork.

Collection of purchased Artwork: To be collected from 4pm to 5pm at completion of the Art Exhibition on Sunday 3 March. Full Payment is required with collection.

Publicity: Permission to use Artworks for publicity purposes is assumed on entry into the competition.

Entry to the Showground:

Exhibitors wishing to enter the showground during the running of the show will pay normal gate prices UNLESS the exhibitor is a member of the Show Association, or you are collecting your exhibits. Please have your receipt for gate entry. Vehicular access is permitted in the lead-up to the Show for the delivery of your exhibits.

You will not be able to drive in to collect your exhibits on the Sunday afternoon 3/3/24.

Membership of the Association - Optional:

Newcastle A.H.&I Association is a not for profit, community - based organization.

ESSENTIAL CRITERIA – CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries Close Wednesday 14 February 2024 - 5pm – No Late Entries Accepted

Please Note: *All Art exhibits must have a suitable cord/wire for hanging.*

1. **Entry Fee:** \$10 Open & \$5 Jnr classes. All exhibitors must complete the GST section on the entry form. All prizes are inclusive of GST where applicable. Please allow for gst to be deducted from sales.
2. **Exhibit Details-Art:** **Back of Exhibit** - Title, price, class entered, artist's name, phone number on back.
3. **JNR ART** - Maximum number per exhibitor- Two exhibits up to ½ square metre.(incl. frame)
4. **OPEN ART** - Maximum number per exhibitor -Three exhibits up to 1metre square, plus one additional allowed up to ½ square metre. (incl. frame) You can enter into any of the classes.
5. **JEWELLERY MAKING – Design must be original with the use of authentic gemstones and precious/semi-precious metals.** The winning exhibit will be showcased at Williams the Jewellers Store at the Junction By entering this class, you agree for your jewellery to be displayed. All care will be taken with exhibits.
6. Any one exhibit cannot be entered in multiple classes. **Entries must have been completed within the last 18 months and original uncopied work of the artist. You must not enter an exhibit that has been previously entered into the Newcastle show.**
7. **Entry Alterations:** Careful consideration should be taken when choosing title and sale price as there are to be no changes to the work entered, its title or sale price etc.
8. **Freight and Insurance:** Exhibitors are responsible for the insurance of works, delivery and freight costs to and from the Newcastle Showground.
9. **Sale of Works:** All entries are to be for sale (Exception Jewellery & Jnr Art, classes, which is optional) with the Art prices in dollars marked on the back, which includes the cost of the frame. A commission of 25% in the Open Artwork & Jewellery (Inc GST) will be charged by the Show Association on all artworks sold which will be deducted from the sale price. *Please ensure you allow for the cost of your frame and any commission which is to be deducted from any sold ART.* We will do our best to deposited funds to your nominated account within two weeks of any sale.
10. **Judging:** All eligible entries will be judged, however, due to limited space, it will be at the discretion of the Committee regarding hanging of Art exhibits. **Judging** for Art & Jewellery is closed to the public and will take place on Monday 26 February 2024. All decisions of the judge/judges will be final in all matters and no correspondence will be entered into.
11. **Framing:** *All Artwork must be framed and mounted ready for hanging with 'D' rings and hanging wire/framing cord. Kitchen twine is not acceptable.* Works on Canvas may be stretched over frame.
12. **Sculptures:** If entering a sculpture, please have ready for assembly. *The exhibitor is responsible for providing their own plinth and assembly onsite.* Maximum weight 10kg unless floor mounted. Sculptures will be exhibited in an area with public access. Bollards will be erected around sculptures for additional protection however, it is the artist's responsibility to ensure that adequate stability and protection are incorporated into the work.

13. DELIVERY OF EXHIBITS FRIDAY 23 FEBRUARY 2024: 8.30 AM - 11.00 AM

ART DELIVERY– NEWCASTLE EXHIBITION CENTRE

All works being exhibited must be delivered directly to the Newcastle Showground, **Exhibition Centre.** Vehicle entry via Griffiths Road or walk-through Brown or Curley gates. Directions Griffiths entry – After turning into showgrounds, turn right and follow the road to the very end. The Exhibition Centre is situated just in front.* Works delivered outside these times will not be accepted.

JEWELLERY DELIVERY: - NEWCASTLE SHOW OFFICE

Entry by car – Griffiths Road. Take the right-hand road, when entering. Alternatively, walk through Curley Road gates, Broadmeadow.

14. COLLECTIONS OF EXHIBITS: SUNDAY 3 MARCH 2024

Between 4.00 PM - 5.00 PM – Not before 4.00 PM

JEWELLERY COLLECTION – NEWCASTLE SHOW OFFICE

Written authority must be given to agents of exhibitors not collecting works personally.

Note: Your Receipt must be presented when collecting exhibits at Brown or Curley Rd. Gates from 4pm-5pm Sunday, and not before. No vehicles are to be on the grounds on the Sunday as the show will still be in progress.

. Newcastle Show closes 5pm Sunday.

- 15 **Exhibits not collected:** Exhibits will be held at the Show Association office for 3 weeks after the Show for collection.
- 16 **Care and Responsibility:** The Association will exercise all reasonable care and security in the handling and exhibition of works submitted but will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any work while in its custody. Please list special handling instructions, if any, with entry.

NEWCASTLE SHOW ART COMPETITION/EXHIBITION

Note: Not adhering to the “Essential Criteria” Page, could result in disqualification

ALL ART works must be ready for hanging via a secure wire/cord on back .

ART CAN BE A PAINTING/ DRAWING -Any media, including mixed media/lino Exception 407/408

Up to 3 x exhibits up to 1 square metre and (an additional) 1 x exhibit up to ½ square metre.

Total of 4 x exhibits within above guidelines. You may enter exhibits in any of the relative classes.

JUNIOR Classes - Classes 409, 410 & 411– Up to 2 x exhibits ½ square metre max size.
